

2019 Japanese College Visit Tour

Lighthouse Hawaii and Hawaii Global Education Foundation (HGEF) have designed a series of campus visit tours for local high school students, regardless of their ability to speak/understand Japanese, to visit colleges/universities in Japan.

Six (6) top level universities in Tokyo are hand-picked for this inaugural tour. These universities offer liberal arts (including linguistics, foreign language, international communication and culture, professional arts) and interdisciplinary and other academic studies.

Dates: June 1 (Sat) – 8 (Sat), 2019

Target: Grade 9 – 12 in 2019-2020 School Year
(up to 15 students; first-come, first-served basis)
*Teacher, parent(s), and family members are allowed to join; please consult with us.

Itinerary:

June 1 (Sat)	Depart from Honolulu (morning) by Japan Airlines
June 2 (Sun)	Arrive in Tokyo (evening); orientation
June 3 (Mon)	Oberlin University
June 4 (Tue)	Sophia University
June 5 (Wed)	International Christian University (ICU)
June 6 (Thu)	Keio University Shonan Fujisawa Campus
June 7 (Fri)	Toyo University or Tsukuba University (choose one)
June 8 (Sat)	Free time until departure from the hotel Depart from Tokyo (evening) by Japan Airlines Arrive in Honolulu (morning)

***You must attend 5 campus tours.**

Lodging: National Olympic Memorial Youth Center, Tokyo

- Participants are **required to stay** here with the group.

Cost: **\$1,550 per person**

Included:

- Roundtrip airfare
- Accommodation
- Program fee

Not included:

- Meals (expect for food on board flights)
- Traveler's insurance – required to purchase in order to participate
- Ground transportation

The following requirements and deadlines apply to **ALL** participants:

Requirements (**due by Thursday, February 28**):

- Application form
- Waiver of liability
- Copy of the current US or Japanese passport
- Proof of traveler's insurance
- \$200 non-refundable deposit to secure a spot

Deposit: \$200 (non-refundable)

- This deposit must be paid by check and received at HGEF in order to secure your spot.
- Once application is complete, the amount will be credited and applied to the balance.

Chaperon: A bilingual staff from Nippo Tourist in Tokyo

Activities at each campus (subject to change):

- General session
- Campus tour, including dorms if available
- Student exchange program
- Observation and/or experience of actual lectures when available
- Individual Q&A session (need an appointment via HGEF prior to departure)

You may choose to join us in Japan if you are already there or choose different departure/return dates. The flight arrangements should be made on your own.

Cost: **\$650 per person**

Included:

- Accommodation (no refund when you choose to stay elsewhere)
- Program fee

Not included:

- Meals
- Traveler's insurance – required to purchase in order to participate
- Ground transportation
- Escort from Lighthouse or HGEF

Application deadlines:

- All documents must be completed **by Friday, March 15**
- The final payment must be received in mail or hand-delivered **by Monday, April 15**.
